



The National Democratic Party of Alabama was founded with the following objectives and principles.

WE RESOLVE:

1. To support the platform and programs of the National Democratic Party of the United States and to provide a vehicle in Alabama for their expression and implementation.
2. That all voters in the State of Alabama have the right to vote for any and all major candidates for the highest offices in our land; and that any breach or abrogation of this right is an **INEXCUSABLE VIOLATION OF THE PUBLIC TRUST**, regardless of the financial, political or social station of those persons who have allowed such a situation to exist in fact.
3. That the hostile racial atmosphere in our state is an artificial situation which has been deliberately cultivated by our traditional political leaders; they have a vested interest in setting the races against each other, specifically for the exploitation and deprivation of the vast majority of Alabama's people, both black and white. We are determined to put an end to this vicious, unconscionable conspiracy against the people of Alabama.
4. To re-establish meaningful and effective communication and co-operation with the national administration in Washington.
5. To provide an opposition voice to the political Lilliputianism of the conservative right.
6. To facilitate progressive educational and economic programs designed to upgrade the standard of living of ALL Alabama citizens.
7. To establish a vigorous political party that will develop and supervise effective campaigns for national, state and local candidates.
